Internet Acceptable Usage Agreement

Dear Parent/Caregivers,

Children at our school have access to the Internet. This access is through a managed system called Connect-ED and there is some in-built protection against inappropriate material that may be on the Internet. Internet and email use can be monitored at school. The school requires that the student's parent or guardian sign a statement giving permission for access to the Internet as part of the curriculum.

In Years 1 and 2, the teachers will discuss with the children expected behaviours and responsibilities. Please also discuss these expected behaviours and responsibilities with your child before you sign and return this form. Your child will not be able to use the school's Internet connection if the signed form is not returned.

Student's expected responsibilities and behaviours

I will only use the Internet at school when my teacher says to.

I will only use the Internet when a teacher, teacher aide or classroom volunteer is with me.

I will only use Internet sites that my teacher asks me to.

If I see something on the Internet that makes me feel bad or uncomfortable, I will quietly tell my teacher.

I will not tell anyone on the Internet my address or phone number.

I understand that if I break these rules, I will not be allowed to use the Internet.

Parent/Guardian

I understand that the Internet can provide students with valuable learning experiences. I also understand that it gives access to information on computers around the world; that the school cannot control what is on those computers; and that a very small part of that information can be illegal, dangerous or offensive. School administration or their delegate will monitor student usage of Internet and email resources. I accept that, while teachers will always exercise their duty of care, protection against exposure to harmful information should depend finally upon responsible use by students.

I believe that _____ [*Name of student*] understands this responsibility, and I hereby give my permission for him/her to access the Internet under the school rules. I understand that students breaking these rules will be subject to appropriate action by the school. For minor breeches loss of Internet access for some time may occur. For repeated or serious breeches, consequences for student actions will be determined through the school Behaviour Management Plan.
